## **Vaccine Policy**

At Pediatric Specialists of Foxboro and Wrentham, we are dedicated to providing the highest standard of medical care to our patients. This includes adhering to the American Academy of Pediatric's (AAP) recommended vaccine schedule.

At each visit where vaccines are offered, you will receive a Vaccine Information Statement, which outlines the risks and benefits of each vaccine. You will also have the opportunity to ask any questions about the vaccines your child is scheduled to receive.

We are a practice that firmly believe in vaccines and **EXPECT** that our patients will fully vaccinate.

If you choose not to follow the AAP's recommended schedule, we require you to sign our Vaccine Refusal document, without alterations. This form acknowledges that, despite our medical recommendation, you are opting to decline one or more vaccines.

If you are unwilling to sign this document as it stands, you may be asked to leave the practice. We believe that following the AAP schedule is crucial for protecting our patients and staff, especially those who cannot receive vaccines due to age or medical conditions, and it aligns with our core values as a practice. However, we will continue to provide care for 90 days following your departure.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we strive to provide the best care possible.
